The basic shape of the saxophone is a "cone"-the various curves and bends are simply to make it easier to hold. The clarinet is essentially a "cylinder", with a bell which flares out at the end. While both the clarinet and saxophone are single reed instruments, it is this difference in shape which makes them sound so unlike each other.
