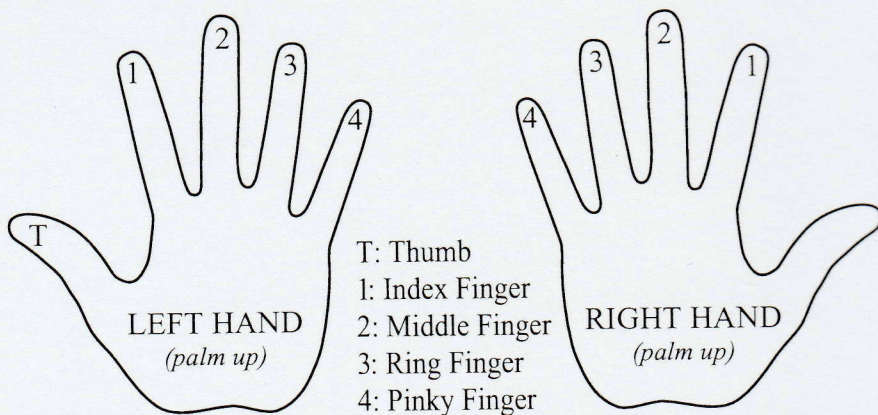


ALTO SAX FINGERING CHART

LH Thumb

F or Fork Key*

B $\flat$ or Bis Key*

LEFT HAND KEYS

T – Thumb

p1, p2, p3 – Palm

1 LH 1 – Index finger

2 LH 2 – Middle finger

3 LH 3 – Ring finger

4a, 4b, 4c, 4d – Pinky finger

RIGHT HAND KEYS

1 RH 1 – Index finger

2 RH 2 – Middle finger

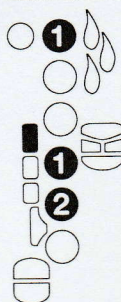
3 RH 3 – Ring finger

4a, 4b – Pinky finger

1a, 1b, 1c – Index finger

3a – Ring finger

*These two L.H. keys (Fork & Bis) are used in advanced musical passages. Consult your teacher for proper usage.
